- Strategic plan with measurable objectives



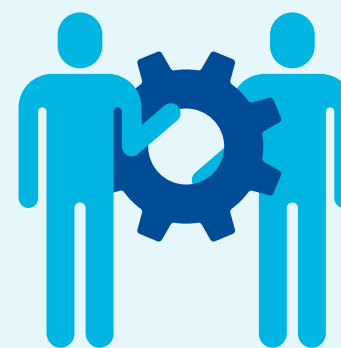
Facility & Equipment Standards

- Safe and accessible spaces



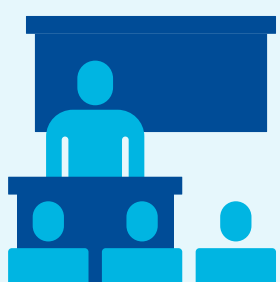
Policies & Compliance

- Multi-disciplinary scenario library



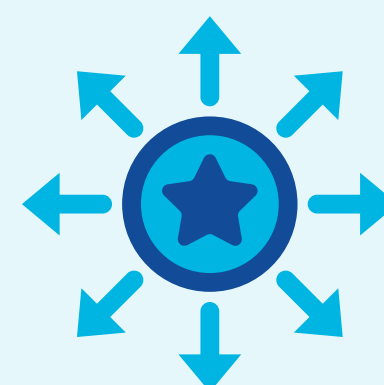
Assessment & Evaluation
